RESPECT OUR LIVESTOCK AND OUR WILDLIFE: KEEP YOUR PET UNDER CLOSE CONTROL - PREFERABLY ON A LEAD - AT ALL TIMES

GROUND-NESTING BIRDS. During the breeding season (April - July) keep your dog on a short lead or under close control to avoid disturbing birds that nest on the ground. This is especially important on sea/loch shoreline, machair and wet flushes.

FARM ANIMALS. Never allow your dog to run freely among livestock. Don't take your dog into fields with lambs, calves or other young farm animals.

SAFETY AROUND CATTLE. Cattle can act aggressively. Avoid them where possible. Keep yourself and your dog at a safe distance. If necessary, let your dog go so that you can both seek safety outside the enclosure.

PLANTED FIELDS. Don't take your dog into crop fields unless there is a clear path. Remove any waste carefully.

PUBLIC PLACES. Keep your dog under close control and avoid causing concern to others, especially those who fear dogs.

DOG WASTE. Remove pet waste and dispose of it in a PUBLIC bin.
